2008 State Convention Special Edition!!!

The Convention Committee has finalized the details for the 2008 Annual Florida State Convention. The Convention is going to be at the Hilton Ocala, 3600 SW 36th Ave, Ocala, Florida, which is located at Exit 350 off of Interstate 75. Although the Convention formally begins on Sunday, December 7th, there is a Pre-Convention event on Saturday, December 6th (see page 4). The deadline for Hotel Reservations and Convention Registration is November 15, 2008. Please remember to send your Convention Registration in early to State President Robert Ramieh at his address on the Registration Form. However, you must contact the Hilton to make your room reservations at 1-877-602-4023, or you may go to the Florida High Twelve Website of www.flhi12.org and click on "Hilton Hotel Reservations". All of the rooms are \$89.00, plus tax, for a total of \$96.57. This Hilton is well worth the extra \$10.00 over last year's hotel as it has just completed a multimillion dollar remodel.

Information concerning meals for the Convention is shown on the Registration Form on page 3 of this Newsletter. For a change in Convention Entertainment, for Sunday, we are trying to book either an stand-up "improv" comedy act or a comedy-magic act. There will a musical group for our entertainment on Monday evening.

The Jewelry Emporium and Gift Card Raffle Sales will be located in the same room of the Hotel. We will be allowed full access to this room when other events are not scheduled. The Convention Hospitality Room will be hosted by Lake Placid High Twelve Club #595 in Room #207. All Members of Lake Placid Club invite you to attend for more than just a place to sit and drink a cup of coffee. Come enjoy the fellowship, refreshments and games.

Brunch with "Buddy" can be enjoyed on Sunday Morning. Buddy is a Clydesdale Horse and is billed as the "most photographed celebrity" in Ocala. Any Hotel Guest with a Hotel key can use the exercise room as well as the Guest Business Center next to the exercise room. The lobby of the Hotel is a WIFI hotspot.

Training Seminars are scheduled for all High Twelvians during the Convention. Please check the schedule for dates, locations and times.

Silver Springs and Wild Water's Park, Appleton Museum, Ocala Breeder's Sales Complex and World Famous Horse Farms are all nearby. For your shopping pleasure, the Paddock Mall is about one mile east of the Hilton and a new mall, named Market Street, approximately one mile west of the Hilton.

This "Tea Party" is open to all Ladies attending the Convention. Another Lady's Program is being put together. Tickets for both functions will be included in each Attendee's Registration Packets.

Also offered are Booster ads which consist of either one or more single lines in a separate section of the booklet. The cost is \$15.00 for the first line and \$5.00 for each additional line.

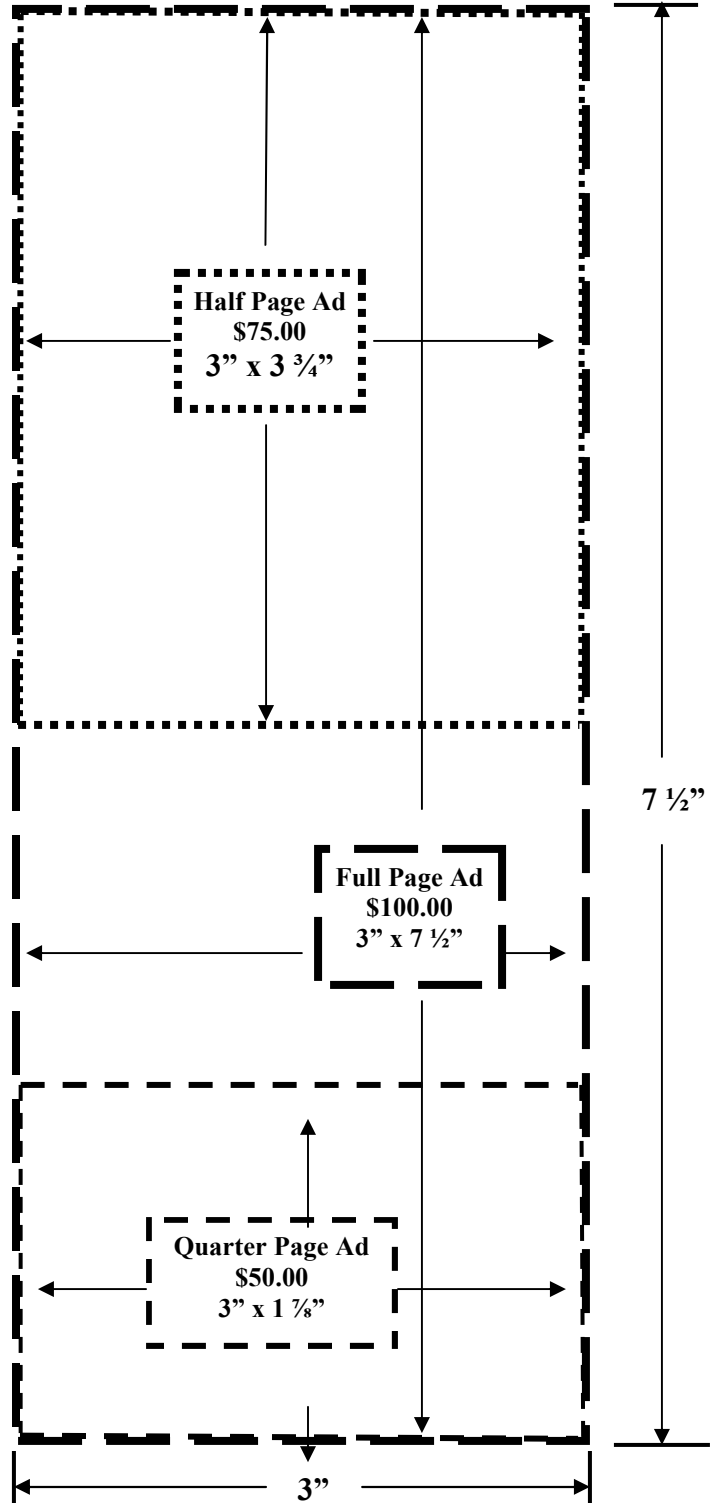

The Hilton Hotel is located at exit 350 (SR-200) just east of I-75 on the right hand side of the road. Hotel is back off the road but a large Hilton Hotel sign gives you warning where to turn in, then follow their signs.

2008 STATE PRE-CONVENTION SPECIAL EVENT

Its time to start thinking about making your hotel reservations for the Annual Florida State Convention.

The Florida State Convention is scheduled for December 7th, 8th and 9th, 2008 at the Hilton Hotel in Ocala, FL. For Hotel reservations there is a link on the Florida State Association website or call 877-602-4023 or 352-854-1400.

Here's a chance to "jump start" your Florida Convention with fun and fellowship for those arriving early on Saturday, December 6th. This event is a trip to the *Don Garlits Museum of Drag Racing and Classic Cars*. The cost of this event including transportation to and from the Museums is \$20.00 per person.

For those attending this event, there will be a bus leaving the hotel parking lot at 2:00pm. Timing is of the utmost importance as the number of bus seats is limited to 25 attendees. Following the tour, the bus will return the attendees to the

Hilton. The Museums close at 5:00pm. Dinner is on your own Saturday evening. There is a restaurant in the Hotel and other restaurants within walking distance.

There are 95 antique vehicles on display at the Classic Car Museum. One car is a 1956 Chrysler Imperial that belonged to President Dwight D. Eisenhower after leaving office as President. The oldest car on display is a 1917 Model-T Ford. There are over 150 various types of race cars on display in the Racing Museum, as well as other racing memorabilia from the early days of drag racing to the present.

The building is no larger than the average mall (50,000 sq ft), and there are seats throughout the Museum, if needed. The average length of time to view both Museums is two hours.
